## Dune buggy rental las vegas

If you buy or build a dune buggy for off-road driving, you need to think about how to get to the dunes in one. Some buggies are street legal, and can simply be operated from place to place. Those that do not require a truck with the right towing equipment. The laws that allow an off-road car to be street legally vary from state to state. In general, this means you need things like windshield wipers, headlights, seat belts, turn signals, proper brakes, a speedometer and a license plate. Of course, it's probably easier to make a street-legal dune buggy out of an existing vehicle rather than custom-built one from scratch. Skydiving, you gear up in a jumpsuit and step into a cylindrical chamber where 120-mile-per-hour winds push you upwards, so you experience the free-falling feeling of jumping out of a plane. For those who'd rather experience actual skydiving over the Strip, Las Vegas Outdoor Adventures will teach you how to jump out of a helicopter.
